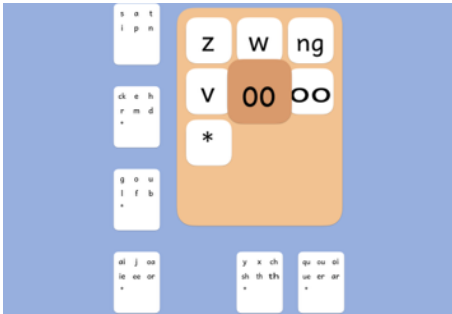


PBPhonics

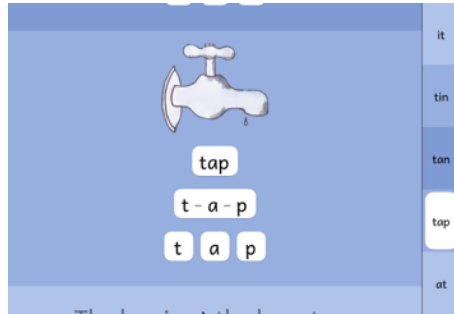


PBPhonics is for adults and young adults studying basic English literacy, including those learning English as a second language.

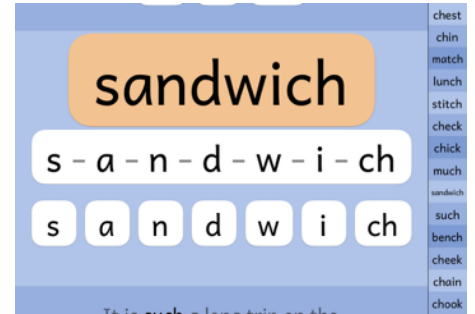
It shows how words can be built by sounding out their component phonemes, and then tests on recognition of those words.



PBPhonics contains up to 42 phonemes in 7 sets:
s a t i p n, c k e h r m d,
g o u l f b, a i j o a i e e e o r,
z w n g v o o o o and
y x c h c h s h t h t h.



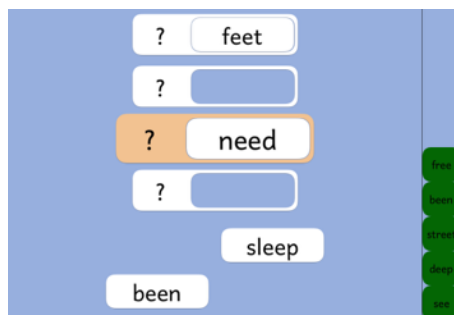
It displays words broken into their component phonemes. Each button speaks to demonstrate the part it plays.



Beginners start with a simple set of words which expands with practice.



Students may record their speech and hear it played back in sequence with the PBPhonics recordings.



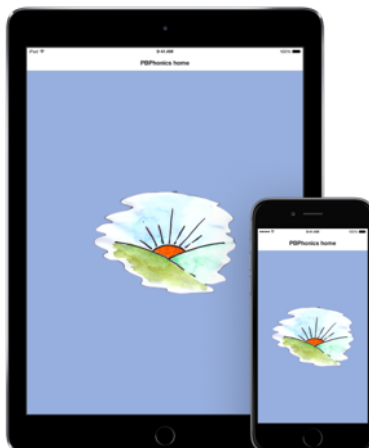
PBPhonics also provides multiple-choice tests on the words. The tests also become more complex with practice.



Help is offered through animated gestures.
